Approval of last meetings minutes

School Land Trust Goals & Update

- As educators at Sandy Elementary, we will ensure that by May of 2016, all students will improve their literacy levels by at least a year's growth, based on the spring CBM for 2nd - 5th grades, the Nonsense Word Fluency-Whole Word Read (NWF-WWR) for 1st grade, and the Letter Sound Fluency (LSF) for kindergarten.
- CBM Assessments are given in the Fall, Winter, and Spring
 - Fall: 60% of all of our students are currently at benchmark established by Canyons School District. Teachers are meeting and talking on a weekly basis about how to meet the needs of our students.

Budget Update (McKay Robinson, Principal)

- A total of \$39,904 was allocated to Sandy for the 2015-2016 school year. That money is being used to pay for four (4) Tier II Interventionists to provide a second level of support in reading.

- Currently we are on track to be able to finish out the year with our interventionists working every weekday until the end of the year. Our LandTrust monies will run out if they all work every day, but Mr. Robinson has budgeted money from a different source to cover any additional costs.

Update on South Side Project

- McKay met with district and city officials and discussed the concerns about the south side and the safety issues. The possibility of closing the fence was discussed, but the city and district wants to make sure that this is for sure what we want before they put the money toward redoing the road. McKay and Diana are going to continue to monitor the south side and the front to collect as much data as possible. McKay will also draw up a couple of other options. This will continue to be a work in progress until the best decision is made for the safety of all of our students at Sandy.
