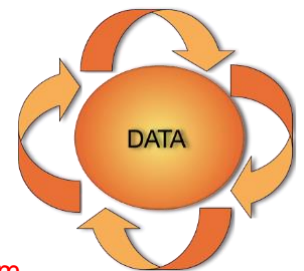

1. School Safety and Security
 - a. This year, we have had a fire drill and an emergency lockdown drill

2. SCC By-Laws
 - a. Review and adjust
 - i. By-laws that were adopted in 2016 were revisited and adjusted accordingly. We made the necessary changes that were required due to state laws that were adjusted. Adjustments were made and we unanimously agreed to the changes made. The by-laws will be available online once they are approved at the district level.
3. Final Report for 2017-2018 School Year
 - a. Data discussion
 - i. Regarding our goals from last year, we exceeded our writing goal of increasing our scores by 10% by over 11%. We made an overall increase of 21.6% in writing.
 - ii. Regarding our math goal, we did not meet our goal of 75% of our students reaching benchmark, but we did have 62% of our students meet benchmark which is a 15% increase from the year before. Although we



did not get 75%, we still made some great growth and are excited about where we are heading.
